Town Council Meeting Minutes – April 6, 2010

The Sanford Town Council met at 7:00 p.m. in the Chambers of the Sanford Town Hall Annex on Tuesday, April 6, 2010. Those present were: **COUNCILORS:** Vice-Chair Kevin J. Old Business

- 10-20.03 Ordered, to authorize Sanford Police Officers to exercise Optional Powers as allowed by MRSA Title 30-A, Section 2671,2-A within the guidelines established by the Standard Operating Procedures #10078 as approved by the Chief of Police. Police Chief Thomas Connolly explained the optional powers to the Council. Vice-Chair Chabot added that the Public Safety Sub-Committee has reviewed and approved it unanimously. Councilor Mastraccio moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Paul. The Town Council voted 5-0 to approve.
- 10-28.04 Ordered, to accept a bid from Pike Industries in the amount of \$4,585,445.00 for the Reconstruct, Shift, Mark, Light and Sign Runway 7-25 at the Sanford Regional Airport. Airport Manager Dana Parry explained the bid and project. Councilor Mastraccio moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Wilkins. The Town Council voted 4-1 to approve. Councilor Walsh opposed.

New Business

- 10-33.01 Ordered, to approve modifications to the current collective bargaining agreement between the Town of Sanford and the Sanford Police Association. Police Officer Eric Small read a letter to the Council. Councilor Mastraccio moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Wilkins. The Town Council voted 5-0 to approve. Councilor Walsh thanked the Police Union.
- 10-34.02 The Town Council hereby proclaims May 1, 2009 as Silver Star Day. Councilor Paul moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Wilkins. The Town Council voted 5-0 to approve.
- 10.35.03 Ordered, to receive, from the Town Treasurer, tax acquired property due to maturity of 2007/2008 real estate tax liens. Town Treasurer Paula Simpson explained. Councilor Mastraccio moved to approve as listed, seconded by Councilor Walsh. The Town Council voted 5-0 to approve.
- 10-36.04 Ordered, to authorize a transfer of criminal forfeiture in relation to a drug enforcement case handled by the Sanford Police Department. The amount of currency to be received by the Sanford Police Department is \$1,709.60 and two (2) rifles. Councilor Mastraccio moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Wilkins. The Town Council voted 5-0 approve.
- 10-37.05 Ordered, to award a bid for the re-roofing of the Town Hall. Director of Recreation and Public Property Marcel Blouin explained the bid process and recommends the award of the bid to go to Olde Mohawk Masonry and Historic Restoration Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$132,900.00. Councilor

Mastraccio moved to approve as recommended, seconded by Councilor Wilkins. The Town Council voted 5-0 to approve.
