- 09-79.01 To act on an order, to review appointments, reappointments and resignations:
- 1) To re-appoint Jamie Cole as the Town of Sanford Codes Enforcement Officer and Alternate Local Plumbing Inspector for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. Councilor Mastraccio moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Paul. The Town Council voted 6-1 to approve. Councilor Walsh opposed.
  - 2) To re-appoint Shirley Sheesley as the Town of Sanford Chief Codes Enforcement Officer and Local Plumbing Inspector for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. Councilor Mastraccio moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Chabot. The Town Council voted 7-0 to approve.
- 09-80.02 Ordered, to accept an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$30,825.00 for the Sanford Police Department. Councilor Walsh moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Chabot. The Town Council voted 7-0 to approve.
- 09-81.03 Ordered, to approve a 3 year collective bargaining agreement from July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2011 between the Town of Sanford and the Sanford Regional Communications Association. Councilor Chabot moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Paul. The Town Council voted 7-0 to approve.
- 09-82.04 Ordered, to adopt a resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Sanford, Maine, exercising its power of eminent domain to take certain blighted property (Aerofab, Inc.) for purposes of abating the blight. Vice-Chair Herlihy moved to adopt the resolution, seconded by Councilor Littlefield. The Town Council voted 6-1 to approve. Councilor Walsh opposed.
- 09-83.05 Ordered, to adopt a resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Sanford, Maine, exercising its power of eminent domain to take certain blighted property (Northern Properties, LLC) for the purposes of abating the blight. Vice-Chair Herlihy moved to adopt the resolution, seconded by Councilor Littlefield. The Town Council voted 6-1 to adopt the resolution. Councilor Walsh opposed.

- 1) Ordered, to approve a blanket letter for Game of Chance (Daily Pool) for the AMVETS Post #3, 169 School Street, Sanford, ME. Councilor Littlefield moved to approve, seconded by Councilor Chabot. The Town Council voted 7-0 to approve.
