

ELECTION INFORMATION

- The State General & Referendum and Municipal Election is scheduled for Tuesday Nov 8, 2016. Sample ballots and other election information is posted in the City Clerk's Office and the City Website as soon as available.

- Absentee ballots should be available by October 7th. Anyone who wants to vote may come to the City Clerk's office (8:00 AM – 4:30 PM) to vote in person or request to bring a ballot home to vote. Please call before coming down to be sure ballots are ready.
 - If unable to come in person, you can call the Clerk's office @ 324-9125 to have one mailed to you.

- The last day to request an absentee ballot is **THURSDAY NOVEMBER 3rd**. The Clerk's office will be open until **7:00 PM** that evening for people to can come in person to vote, or register if needed.
 - Beginning **Friday November 4th** voters will need to qualify for **special circumstances** in order to request a ballot.

- Election Day – November 8th – polling places will be open 8 AM – 8 PM. Polling locations are

Ward 2: St. Ignatius Gym, 25 Riverside Ave., Sanford
Ward 3: Curtis Lake Church, 38 Westview Dr., Sanford
