


Sanford School Construction Project

Phase I: Integrated High School & Technical Center

Construction is underway for a new state of the art Sanford High School and Regional Technical Center. This state-funded \$100 million facility is scheduled to open in September 2018 and will be the largest school construction project in Maine's history. Additional local funding was approved by taxpayers in January 2016 to create a community performing arts center and athletic field enhancements.

Goals for Phase I—Sanford High School & Technical Center Construction Project

- ◆ Prepare students to be Career and College ready by creating a state of the art, integrated high school and technical center with four distinct career pathways— *Science and Technology; Human Services; Business & Marketing; and Arts & Communication.*
- ◆ Provide skilled employees to regional manufacturers by offering students training in innovative and high-demand career technical education programs.
- ◆ Reduce operations and maintenance costs by designing an energy efficient facility.
- ◆ Increase safety and security by eliminating all modular classrooms city-wide.
- ◆ Establish a community Performing Arts Center to provide educational and cultural enrichment opportunities, and encourage enjoyment of the performing arts in our community.
- ◆ Consolidate athletic fields on one campus and provide a stadium with an artificial turf field and track.




Phase II: Pre-K through Grade 8 School Improvements

Sanford has been approved to receive additional state funding to renovate and expand its elementary schools and to renovate and reuse the current Sanford High School facility as a new grade 5-8 middle school.

Goals for Phase II—Elementary School Construction Project

- ◆ Create three Pre-K to grade 4 elementary schools—North, Central and South—with equitable facilities and program offerings.
- ◆ Construct an addition to Margaret Chase Smith School and update the facility to increase student capacity and improve classrooms and outdoor areas.
- ◆ Renovate and update Sanford Junior High School to the Central Elementary School to accommodate Pre-K to grade 4 students.
- ◆ Create a middle school to house all grade 5-8 students by reusing and renovating the current Sanford High School facility.
- ◆ Reduce operations and maintenance costs by consolidating programs and closing two older elementary schools.
- ◆ Increase safety and security by eliminating all modular classrooms city-wide.
- ◆ Provide space for future growth and building expansion.
