CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

**THIS PROGRAM IS WEATHER
PERMITTING**

Christmas trees will be picked up by the Sanford Public Works Department starting Tuesday, January 7, 2014 thru Friday January 17, 2014 **ONLY**. The trees need to be put out on the day of your regularly scheduled rubbish pickup. However the trees may not be picked up on that exact day. The crews will pick them up sometime during this two week period. Trees are to be left whole and they must be left close to the street curb. They will be picked up by municipal employees for recycling. All decorations must be removed. They will not be taken if they are frozen into the snow. Following Jan. 17th, 2014; if due to inclement weather the crews are not able to pick them up, the resident would then be responsible to dispose of the tree themselves.

Any resident may take their own Christmas tree at no charge to the transfer station debris area during the hours of Tuesday thru Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and on Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. until noon.
