City Council Meeting Minutes – October 29, 2013

Public Hearings

The City Council will hold public hearings on the following:

1. The continuance of the ordinance entitled Petition to Overrule of Actions of the Council Chapter 105 Section 1-1302. Mayor Herlihy declared the public hearing open at 7:50pm. Mayor Herlihy explained the changes from the prior charter. Jim Drummey of Springvale voiced his concern regarding no time constraint. He feels it is limiting the voter's rights. Councilor Walsh voiced his concerns regarding the suspension of actions. There were no other comments. This public hearing will be continued thru the November 12th Council Meeting.
