Subject: Downtown Sanford Planning Partnership Initiative Meeting #2

The City of Sanford, in cooperation with MaineDOT and VHB, is hosting its second virtual meeting on July 9, 2020 at 6:00 pm. The purpose of the meeting is to review the concepts being developed towards a vision for a revitalized Downtown and guide the design of improved transportation infrastructure.

This meeting is part of Sanford's Downtown Planning Partnership Initiative (PPI). The PPI process encourages soliciting the valuable input of local residential and business stakeholders to better understand the needs of the community. Identification of the benefits and shortcomings of the existing conditions took place in the first meeting on April 16, 2020 (video presentation online) and we have some proposed improvements and corresponding costs for further discussion.

Please Note:

1. The discussion of existing and proposed conditions will be focused on vehicular, multi-modal, and pedestrian transportation infrastructure improvements for function, safety, and innovation.
2. The study area includes Main Street from Lebanon to Emery Street, Washington Street from Main Street to High Street, and School Street from Washington Street to Elm Street.
3. You can view existing conditions plans for Downtown in person, prior to the meeting, outside City Hall's storefront window at 919 Main Street between the Sanford Mainer's Office and the Sanford-Springvale Chamber of Commerce. The graphic will also be available on the City's Web Page as noted below.
