### The City of Sanford Announces One 2020 Opening on the Sanford Housing Authority Board of Commissioners

The Sanford Housing Authority Board of Commissioners has one (1) opening for a resident to fill an unexpired term ending 12/31/2020. This position serves as a Tenant Representative on the Board and must be a recipient of housing owned or managed by the Sanford Housing Authority. You can have a voice and bring relevant tenant issues, concerns and ideas to the Board.

The purpose and mission of the Housing Authority is to provide decent, safe and affordable housing to eligible low-income applicants within our jurisdiction. The role of the Board is to develop policy and monitor performance of all Federal and State housing programs. Commissioners are responsible for overseeing the operations of the Housing Authority and expenditures of federal monies, helping direct the management of programs that benefit the community, and ensuring the provision of quality services to the residents of our housing properties. We will provide training for new Commissioners. Meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month at 4 PM.

Members of the Sanford Housing Authority's Board of Commissioners set policies, establish and adopt an annual and five-year action plan, and adopt an annual operating budget. The Board is made up of seven (7) Commissioners appointed by the Sanford City Council. Two (2) of the Commissioners must be tenants of Sanford Housing Authority. Commissioners each serve for a term of three years. The terms are staggered so that at least one vacancy occurs each year. Commissioners may serve successive terms if allowed by the Council.
