2. Boy Scout Aviation Camporee Quick Note



- Total estimated operations (takeoffs and landings) at SFM for 2014 as of July 1st is 10,158


Estimate of Aircraft Operations Per Day For the 06 Month 2014




Estimate of Total Aircraft Operations for the 06 Month is 3260

4. Seacoast Taxilane Reconstruction Project: Construction Grant Offer

We have prepared for, sought, and obtained a grant offer for the construction phase of the Seacoast Taxilane Rehabilitation. This project includes the rehabilitation of the 26+ year old pavement and improvements to the drainage in the area on the southeast side of the Seacoast Hangar I complex. The project is scheduled to begin in early fall to minimize impact to tenants. September 8th is the tentative construction start date with a total duration of 28 days.
